Living Alternatives Pregnancy Resource Center is a 501c3 non-profit organization. This faith-based ministry began in 1985 and will celebrate 39 years of ministry in September. Every year, we get a little stronger, do things a little better, and gain a new perspective on where God is leading us next.



2023 Theme — Fiercely Loved

Last year, we asked the Lord to show us what it means to fiercely love God by fiercely loving others. We asked the Lord to give us a new lens to see each person who reached out to us for help. As we pressed into the God who fiercely loves us, the Lord shaped our faith through the experiences and stories each woman shared.

Many of the women we had the privilege of serving in 2023 came to us wounded by the message that they would never be good enough. They had accepted words like damaged, hopeless, unworthy, and broken.

In response to this heartbreaking reality, we gifted each of our clients with the word LOVED. We even gave each client a shirt that says FIERCELY LOVED across the front of it as a reminder to her that she is loved by God and loved by us. Our prayer for her came from Ephesians 3:16-19:

I pray that out of his glorious riches [the Father] may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. – Ephesians 3:16-19

Accomplishing the Mission

Praise God — He surprised us with another year of substantial increase! We are celebrating the accomplishment of our mission reflected in the statistics below:

- Two years in a row, we have seen a 21% increase in the number of women we served from 2,785 in 2021 to 3,368 in 2022 to 4,057 in 2023! 66% of our 2023 clients were brand new to our ministry. That's 2,686 women, along with their families, that we met for the first time in 2023!
- We also saw a 15% increase in overall client visits, going from 10,576 in 2022 to 12,139 opportunities in 2023.

- We performed 1,572 pregnancy tests and 1,728 ultrasounds.
- 35% of our 2023 clients were 24 years of age or younger, and 85% were unmarried.
- The gospel was presented 218 times and 3,964 spiritual discussions or times of prayer were reported. 27 individuals prayed to receive Jesus as Lord. We are praising God for these spiritual decisions!

- 678 women were considering abortion or being pressured by a significant other to terminate their pregnancy. 82% of the 678 at-risk women we served were planning to carry the pregnancy to term at our last contact with them. We are trusting God with the rest of their story.
- 3,987 parenting classes and 5,856 support services were recorded (support services include adoption support, perinatal grief support, post-abortion, model scans, curbside assistance, and material assistance).
 - We were grateful to be able to offer Abortion Pill Reversal to women who changed their minds after taking the abortion pill.

We held three Deeper Still retreats in 2023 for men and women seeking freedom and healing from the emotional wounds of an abortion. Here are a few quotes from the 29 individuals who attended a 2023 retreat:

"I struggled with shame, regret, and self-loathing. Never have I met a more gracious group of people. They prayed peace over me and healed my heart. I found forgiveness by the shed blood of <u>Jesus Christ and it has brought</u> me back from the land of the dead. I am at peace. I am worthy."

"I realize now that I can always go deeper and that it's a choice. While at the retreat, I vulnerably laid my heart out before the cross while the ever-most gentle Holy Spirit eased me deeper still. I know some participants cancel and some are hesitant to come but for some reason I was ready... Saturday night at the retreat, I chose the white flag to stand firm in. I swung it back and forth feeling pure for the first time in...well never. I haven't ever felt this pure before and when I laid down underneath the royal banner I made a choice ... and I chose to go wherever God takes me. My flesh fights me so hard at times and that's why I must put on the armor of GOD and continually renew my mind with HIS word."

"Coming into the retreat, I needed healing in the areas of shame, grief, and assurance of my worthiness to God. While at the retreat, I recommitted my life to Christ. I had not been living out my forgiveness. I knew that I was forgiven but was still living in shame. I still have work to do post retreat but knowing that you all care and want to see me whole and healed and living my best life is a really good start and I have hope where I had lost almost all hope."

How LAPRC Began

For those of you who are new to the ministry, Living Alternatives is a faith-based organization that began in 1985 when a young pastor by the name of Gregory Roe felt called by God to do something about the impact abortion was having on women who found themselves in an unplanned pregnancy. This ministry was started on the foundation of obeying God's call, and we continue to daily seek God's wisdom and His provision as we seek to glorify Him in all that we do.

Our goal has never been expansion, but obedience — faithfully responding to each door God so beautifully opens for us. Each year, we ask God what He is calling us to do. This prayer often stretches us out of our comfort zones, yet we are so thankful for how He has allowed the impact of this ministry to continue to grow each year.

Growing the Mission

2023 was our first full year of residential ministry in Bourbonnais, Illinois. Because of the donation of the use of an apartment building by Olivet Nazarene University, we opened a transitional living program called Birchwood Apartments in October of 2022. Four moms are currently living in Birchwood (and 7 little ones). Since 2022, a total of 9 women and 15 little ones have called Birchwood Apartments "home". Our 10th resident has been accepted and is awaiting an opening for the program.

Why did we open Birchwood Apartments?

Over the years, so many PRC clients have told us that they do not have a dependable place to live. Many rely on friends who allow them to crash on their couch for a night, while others live in a shelter or in their car. Because of your faithful giving, we are able to give these mothers a safe place to live with their little one(s). They are working, have found dependable childcare, and have learned how to budget their money so that they will be ready for a stronger future when they leave Birchwood Apartments. More than anything, these amazing women have found community and are growing in their understanding of God's love for them.
